Head Start services are provided to families that meet the program guidelines, which includes families of children with disabilities.

How to apply:

- ◆ Complete Application
- ◆ Proof of Child's age
- ◆ Current Immunization records
- ◆ Current Physical/well check exam
- ◆ For foster parents or legal guardians official documentation is required.
- ◆ Documentation of child's disability/special need/ dietary or allergy food restrictions (if applicable)
- ◆ Child care vouchers (if applicable)
- ◆ Documentation of household income of last year or last 12 months of:
 - ⇒ Money wages or salary before deductions W-2' s all Tax form
 - ⇒ Payments for social security (SSA)
 - ⇒ Payments from unemployment compensation
 - ⇒ Workers compensation
 - ⇒ Veterans benefits
 - ⇒ Public assistance such as Payments for Supplemental Security Income (SSI) and Temporary assistance for needy families (TANF)
 - ⇒ Alimony
 - ⇒ Child support
 - ⇒ Government employee pensions
 - ⇒ University scholarships, grants, fellowships and assistantships
